

ACOOSE DEFEATS APPLEBY

Winnipeg, May 17—Paul Acoose, the Grenfell Chippewa Indian, defeated Appleby, the world's champion fifteen miler here last evening at the Arena rink, winning by a lead of 160 yards.

Appleby started off at a fast clip, but the Indian clung close as a burr, until the seventh mile, when Acoose shot ahead, and before the ninth mile was completed he had gained a lap. From this point on the Indian followed his early tactics, keeping close to Appleby's heels. At the fourteenth mile the Englishman made a hot spurt, but Acoose was equal to the occasion and kept his one lap lead.

On the tenth lap of the 15th mile Acoose shot ahead, but Appleby recovered the ground and on the finish of the Indian's race Appleby was a few yards on his own last lap. He went on and finished in 1.22.46, the Indian's time being 1.22.22.
