

APPLEBY TO MEET ACOOSE IN WINNIPEG

Mr. F. Nelson Smith, of Winnipeg, was a visitor in the city today, returning from Grenfell, where he has been successful in signing on Paul Acoose, the Indian runner, to run against Fred. Appleby, the flatfooted Englishman, in a fifteen mile race at the Arena rink, Winnipeg, about the end of this month.

Acoose is in splendid shape, having kept in training all winter, and will it is thought by many, make the Englishman travel all the way. The Indian will be matched against J. D. Marsh in a second race a few days after he runs against Appleby, and if he makes a good showing against Appleby will in all probability be taken east by Mr. Smith to run against Longboat or any of the other great runners. i
